Three in a Row - Ai-Media Scores Over 99% in Captioning Quality Audit

Speech-to-text innovator Ai-Media has scored 99.21% in its latest independent external captioning quality audit, as measured by the international NER benchmark. The result is the Company's third score in a row of greater than 99%.

Ai-Media provides captioning for broadcasters including Nine Network Australia, Foxtel, Fox Sports, Australian News Channel (Sky News), and others. The audit result announced today is for Ai-Media's third quarter of service to the Nine Network ending September 2014, based on an independent auditor scoring 13 programs at random.

Ai-Media's clients were recently recognised at the Deafness Forum of Australia's Captioning Awards with Foxtel, Nine Network Australia and Victorian Deaf Education Institute taking awards.
